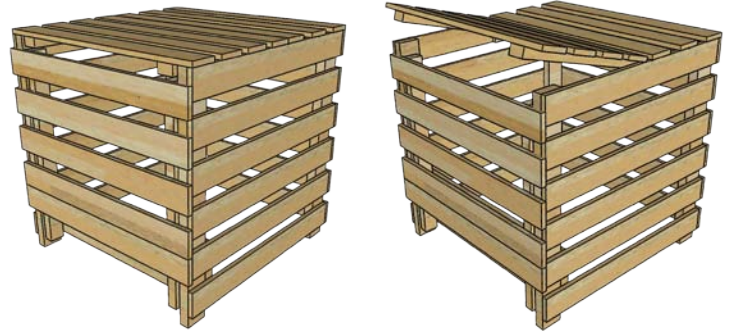

COMPOST BIN

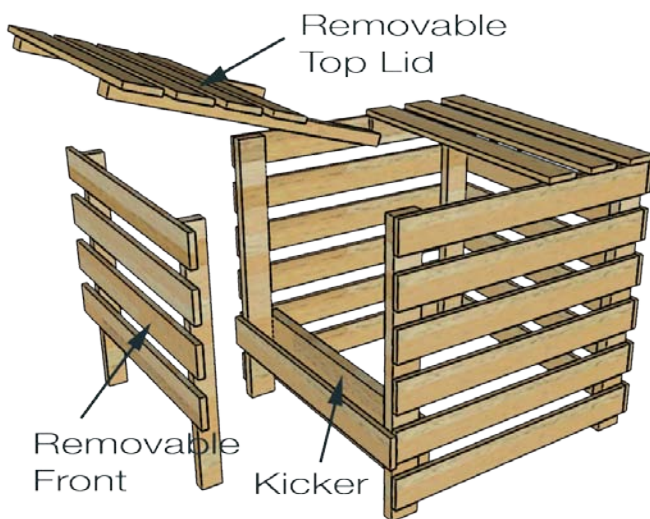
MADE FROM SALVAGED WOOD

Our compost bins measure 3'x3'x3', and are constructed using salvaged wood from reclaimed pallets. They can hold up to one cubic yard of compost.

Each compost bin will look different, as the slats of wood come from different reclaimed pallets. Slats are attached from the outside, so they are easy to replace as needed over the years of use (with nails or screws).



Adding material: The top lid can be tilted with one hand, while dumping organic material into the bin. The lid can also be flipped 180° to remain open (resting on top of the bin) if you are adding a lot of material.



Accessing the pile: Both the top lid and front panel can be completely removed and set aside, making it very easy to access the compost pile for turning and spreading. One can turn the compost using the strong "kicker" board to lever your spade or fork, giving you mechanical advantage. Once your compost is ready to be used in the garden, the bin can be easily emptied using a spade.
